

PUROPTICS® (CARMELLOSE 1.0% W/V EYE DROPS)

Please keep and read this leaflet carefully because it contains important information for you. Ask your pharmacist if you need any more information or advice.

INTENDED USE

Carmellose 1.0% w/v eye drops gives relief to the eyes in case of dryness of the eye film and fatigue. It also alleviates the feeling of irritation caused by dust, smog, pollen, bright light and overexertion.

What Causes Dry Eye Sensation

Dry eye condition associated with the use of VDUs and TVs, infrequent blinking, certain medical treatments, atmospheric pollution and drying atmospheres eg. air-conditioning, central heating, wind and sun). It is also result of ocular surface disorders that can be caused by a number of different reasons where the normal tears are either of poor quality or produced in too little quantity to keep the eye sufficiently moist.

INDICATIONS

For the temporary relief of burning, irritation & discomfort due to the dryness of the eye, or due to exposure to wind, sun, etc, Carmellose eye drops may be used as a protectant against further irritation.

DOSSAGE

The usual dosage is one or two drops in the affected eye(s) as needed, or as directed by your doctor.

WARNINGS AND PRECAUTIONS

Talk to your doctor or pharmacist before using Carmellose 1.0% w/v Eye Drops

- If you develop an eye infection during this treatment,
- If you are wearing contact lenses,
- If you are allergic to carmellose or any other ingredient of this medical device

Other medicines and Hypromellose

Please tell your doctor or pharmacist if you are applying any other type of eye drops or eye ointment before you start to use this eye drops.

Pregnancy and breast-feeding

If you are pregnant or breast-feeding, think you may be pregnant or are planning to have a baby, ask your doctor or pharmacist for advice before taking this eye drops.

Driving and using machines

Carmellose eye drops may cause a temporary blurring of vision immediately after using the drops. Do not drive or operate machines if you experience any visual disturbance after using the product. Wait until this clears before driving or using machines.

POSSIBLE SIDE EFFECTS

Eye irritation (including burning and discomfort), eye pain, itchy eyes, visual disturbance.

Allergic reactions (including eye or eyelid swelling), blurring of vision, increase in tear production (also known as tearing), sticky eye, crusting of the eyelid and/or drug residue, a feeling that something is in your eye, redness of the eye/eyelid, eyesight worsening, eye injury to the surface of the eye due to the tip of the vial touching the eye during use.

COMPOSITION

Each ml contains:
Carmellose Sodium 1.0% w/v
Stabilized Oxychloro complex 0.005% w/v
(As Preservative)
Sterile aqueous base q.s.

STORAGE

Keep this eye drops out of the sight and reach of children.

Do not store above 30°C. Do not freeze.

Do not use this eye drops after the expiry date.

Protect from light.

FOR EXTERNAL USE ONLY

NOT FOR INJECTION

Discard the bottle 28 days after opening, even if there is solution remaining.

PACKAGING:

5ml, 10ml, 15ml & 20ml of solution. Not all pack sizes may be marketed.

INSTRUCTION FOR USE

- First wash your hands
- Tighten the cap on the nozzle to pierce the tip of the eye drop bottle,
- Rotate the cap anticlockwise to break the seal and remove the cap
- If you are a contact lens wearer remove your lenses and do not replace until 30 minutes after using eye drops
- Tilt your head back and look at the ceiling
- Pull the lower eyelid gently downwards
- Hold the bottle upside down above the eye and gently squeeze the bottle to release a drop into your eye
- Avoid touching any part of the eye (or any other surface) with the tip of the bottle
- Keep the affected eye closed and press your fingertip against the inside corner of the closed eye, and hold for 1 minute
- Repeat for the other eye if necessary
- Replace and tighten the cap immediately after use
- These drops are supplied as a sealed bottle with a spiked cap. When using the bottle for the first time, screw the cap down tightly in order to pierce the tip of the bottle

Be careful not to touch the tip of the bottle on your eye or on any other surface.



Eye solutions, if handled wrongly, can become contaminated by common bacteria and cause eye infections.
